On a bright, sunny but chilly day 43 walkers faced the starter among them three making their debut. It was the largest opening race turnout since 2014 when 48 toed the start line. Good turnouts invariably result in good racing and this was the case resulting in at least eight pb's being set and 38 of the 40 walkers who contested the 5 miles doing so under the hour.

Walking impressively Dave Annetts was a clear winner (as he was in 2019) ahead of George Wilkinson and Maddy Shott who both put in good performances. They were not alone in that respect as Silvana Alves posted a huge pb ahead of Millie Morris and Jacqueline Benson and in a gender four-a- side match the ladies with four in the top seven would have been clear winners

The debutants demonstrated good basic technique and posted very respectable times and two of them qualified for their "5 in the Hour" badges

The team competition has the potential to be one of the closest ever because five teams have squads large enough to score heavily and consistently. Enfield and Ilford have taken the lead, but Belgrave and Ashford are within easy touching distance despite not fielding six athletes. Result on page 2

Cath Duhig (CAMT/L) and Steve Allen (Bnt/L) have competed twice in **Spanish competitions**. At the Manuel Alcalde Memorial, Guadix meeting on 28th December Cath won the W45 5km in 30.51 and in the same age category Steve finished 5th in 30.09. Then on January 12th at Buriassot. Steve over 10km finished 17th in 60.39 and over 5km Cath was 16th in 30.03.

Four Leaguers got a prompt start to the year by walking in the **Lee Valley indoor 3km**. There were five contestants and following a spirited effort by Silvana Alves (Bnt) 15.55 to hang onto Francisco Reis (SWC/L) 14.45 he pulled away and was an easy winner. Malcolm Martin SWC/L) 17.45, Geraldine Legon (Bxy/L) 21.14 and Angela Martin (SWC/L) 21.23 made up the field.

Tony Bell (LWC/L) was in action twice during January; in a mid-week meeting in Sheffield on 22nd of the month he finished third of three in a track 3km in a time of 17.58 and four days later finished 6th in the Northern League 10km promoted by Yorkshire Walking Club and staged at Drighlington. The race winners on both occasions was Nathalie Myers (2DASH) in 14.45 and 55.05.

Following on from his fine win in the opening ERWL fixture, a week later in Amsterdam Dave Annetts (NHRR/L) finished runnerup in the **Dutch Winterserie 10km** setting a pb of 47.16 in the process.

Steyning open 15km race on 25th January. The race was won by the 2019 "Outstanding European Master" Ian Richards (Stey) in 78.07. In second place was the first of the three Leaguers at the event; Francisco Reis 80.34, behind him in 6th place Trevor Jones (Stey/L) 86.03 and in 9th Steve Allen 9th in 95.22. Of interest to other leaguers was the 4th place overall position of Steve's clubmate Silvana Alves 85.36, who had the distinction of finishing runner-up lady to Abigail Jennings (AFD) 81.10.

London Open Walks inc **SWRA 10km championship** at Hillingdon Cycle Circuit on Sunday 2nd February were held in bright, breezy conditions. There was the highest turn-out for some years; 43 and of those 18 were Leaguers. The open walks winners were George Wilkinson (EHAC/L) 47.16 which was new pb and Maddy Shott (Bel/L) 50.12.

So far as the championships were concerned; Luc Legon (Bxy) 47.28, Francisco Reis 52.34 and Malcolm Martin 57.52 took the senior men's honours. The under 20 titles (10km for men and 5km women) went to George Wilkinson and Millie Morris (Ash/L) 28.15. Millie pressed on to complete the 10km and was rewarded with a pb of 58.01. Other Leaguers in evidence were Trevor Jones 58.21, Graham Chapman (HRR/L) 58.25, Steve Uttley (IIf/L) 59.26, Chris Hobbs (Ash/L) 59.39, Steve Allen 61.10, Jacqueline Benson (Ash/L) 60.41, Penelope Cummings (AFD/L) 61.14, Melanie Peddle (Ltn/L) 62.25, Helen Middleton (EHAC/L)

65.20, Noel Blatchford (AAC/L) 67.32, Arthur Thomson (EHAC/L) 71.58 and Angela Martin 79.33 who got up from a fall to complete the distance. Comprehensive result in Race Walking Record.

Five ladies and five men made up the field on Saturday 8th February for the Eastern/Essex **Indoor 1 mile** championships at the LVAC.

The finishing order was George Wilkinson 6.52, Emma Dyos (Ilf/)) 8.40, Melanie Peddle 8.43, Keith Palmer (SAC) 9.45, Rachel Lawless (IIf/L) 9.54, Lesley Morris (IIf/L) 10.45 and Pamela Abbott (EHAC) 11.31. George, Emma, Melanie and Rachel all posted new pb', whilst three walkers failed to satisfy the judges.

MARK EASTON

Many of the photographs used in the *Enfield Walker* and indeed national magazines like *Athletic Weekly* are those taken by Mark Easton: *markeaston.zenfolio.com*. However, before took up the camera he was for almost fifteen years one of the country's top walkers.

In the years spanning 1985 and 1999 he won 18 national titles and finished in the first three 20 times. He gained 15 international vests including four for Commonwealth Games and one for the European championships.

Mark's best times illustrate his wide range of ability: 3 km 11.24, 5 km 20.01, 10 km 41.14, One Hour 14.158m, 20 km 84.04, 30 km 2,13,33 50 km 4.03.53 along with six other performances under 4.10.00. He also came out of retirement in 2003 to take part in and win the Centenary London to Brighton (53 miles) in 8.06.15 which was the last ever staged.

Still contributing to the sport in which he excelled, Mark is the current Hon Treasurer of the RWA, so whether anyone requires an action photograph or would like to join the RWA 200 Club, Mark Easton is the man to see!
