CORBISHLEY TO REPRESENT GB & NI AT THE WORLD ATHLETICS RACE WALKING TEAM CHAMPIONSHIPS



Cameron Corbishley (coach: Andi Drake, club: Medway and Maidstone) will represent Great Britain and Northern Ireland at the World Athletics Race Walking Team Championships in Antalya, Turkey on the 21 April 2024.

The athlete was selected to fulfil the aims of the selection policy which were to support athletes who have the potential to finish in the top 12 and also to support developing athletes who may perform well at future Race Walking Team Championships and have the potential to be selected for future major championships.

Corbishley was the sole eligible athlete to achieve a qualification standard for the event when he went inside the 20km race walk standard with a time of 83:09 in Dudince last month.

The 27-year-old's time in Slovakia was just 19 seconds outside his personal best which stands at 82:50 from 2021. He set that time on his way to 18th place at the European Race Walking Championships.

The Medway and Maidstone athlete was 40th at the last World Athletics Race Walking Team Championships in Oman in 2022 and he also competed at the World Athletics Championships over the 50km distance in Doha back in 2019. *Source: British Athletics*

Cameron Corbishley finished 15th with a time of 1:23:09 just 19 seconds off of his PB, but more importantly inside the UKA qualifying time for the WA Race Walking Team Championships in Turkey on 21 April.

Gracie Griffiths produced a brilliant performance to claim a new 10K personal best in Slovakia .

Representing Wales at the prestigious annual Dudinska 50 World Athletics Race Walk Tour Gold Label event, Griffiths was competing against some of the world's top athletes.

The recent UK Athletics Indoor Championships 3000m silver medallist put in a strong performance with an impressive finish to clock a time of 50:46 and claim an excellent 8th place finish.

The time puts Griffiths 15th on the all-time UK Under-20 fastest list and 3rd in the all-time Welsh rankings. It was also agonisingly close to the qualifying standard for the World Race Walking Team Championships which will be held in Antalya, Turkey. (Source: Welsh Athletics website)

European Masters Indoor Championships, Turun (POL) (Sun. 17th Mar. to Sun. 23rd Mar.)

British Masters competing in the European Masters Indoor Championships in Turun rounded off an excellent week following a gold and silver in the 3000m at the start of the week with two golds and a bronze in the 5km road race, **reports Ian Richards**.

In the 3000m we had four men and two ladies with three men and one lady in the 5km. Overall numbers were down but that is not surprising as this is the second year in a row that there has been an indoor championship in Turun and there are expensive trips to Madeira and Gothenburg later this year and Florida next year.









87 men started the 3000m with nine DQs and 56 women and four DQs. the 5km saw 101 men with seven DQs and 69 women with five DQs.

Particular mention should be made of Carolyn Derbyshire's (W45) bronze in the 5km getting back to being competitive again post Covid.

Mick Barker (M85) did exceptionally well with a silver and gold only being given his doctors go ahead to take part just three weeks ago following heart surgery.

The surprise was perhaps Ian Richards with two golds and just one red card over the two races with many comments about his excellent technique after five DQs in international competition over the last two years and numerous DQs in UK races.
