XXXVII Gran Premio Cantones de A Coruna de Marcha La Coruña (ESP) *(Sat. 18th May)*

English Race Walkers take on the World Athletics Race Walking Tour

A small team of four athletes travelled to La Coruna in Spain to compete at the gold level World Athletics Race Walking Tour, *writes Team Manager Verity Snook*. The team was made up of three seniors, Callum Wilkinson (Enfield & Haringey, Robert Heffernan), Cameron Corbishley (Medway & Maidstone, Andi Drake) and Erika Kelly (Northern Isle of Man, Tom Craggs) who competed over the 20km distance; and junior Abby Hughes (Taunton, Dean Miller) who was making her international debut over 10km.

It was all to play for as the senior athletes were chasing European and Olympic Qualification times, hoping to take advantage of the famously fast course in the North West of Spain. The weather was favourable, damp and cool, offering excellent racing conditions whilst the UK basked in the summer sunshine.

The women took to the road first, with Erika maintaining a sensible pace from the early fast kilometres set by the leaders. This was followed shortly after by the junior women's 10km race.

Erika settled into the race working hard in a world class field, she showed determination and consistency. She sadly attracted the judges' attention collecting a two minute penalty, bravely finishing the full distance in 56th position in 1:46:38.

Abby Hughes started at a very quick pace, getting slightly carried away with competitors which she unfortunately paid for midway through the race. She was able to rally and finish very strongly with a clean slate from a technical judging point of view. She finished overall in 6th place with an incredible personal best of 51:35 on her international debut.



Callum Wilkinson and Cameron Corbishley's campaign started two hours later at 7pm. Callum returned to only his second 20km race this season after a long period of injury and rehabilitation. He looked strong and tucked into the leading pack of top world leading race walkers. Callum's consistent kilometres set him up in the first half of the race, looking comfortable and in control, holding on into the second half. The pace dropped slightly in the latter stages to finish in a credible 30th, with a personal best of 1:20:27 under the European and Olympic B qualification, a mere 17 seconds outside the A standard.



Cameron started well with consistent pacing however, around the 15km point he started showing signs of distress, he managed to finish with a stoical performance in 68^{th} place. Despite his time being below what he expected (1:26:37), it was still a valuable experience to compete on the world stage.

Masters

European Masters Non-Stadia Championships, Porto Santo, Maderia (Fri. 17th to Sun 19th May)

In the 10km at the European Masters Non-Stadia Championships held on the island of Maderia there was M75 gold for Ian Richards and W55 bronze for Melanie Peddle. In the M65 age group Stuart Bennett and Colin Harle finished 5th and 7th respectively separated by a mere three seconds. Stuart, Colin, plus Hardeep Minhas collected team silver.

In the 20km held two days later Melanie *(pictured below)* went one better wining W55 silver in 2:08:40. In the M65 race, Stuart (5th), Hardeep (6^{th}) and Colin (7^{th}) again won team silver.

British Masters 1 Mile & 10,000m Championships, Horspath, Oxford (Sun. 26th May)

Original entries for both races were good, *reports Andrew Clough*, but several non-appearances led to the situation where everyone would be a medallist as long as they could get past the judges' scrutiny.

In the Mile four competitors toed the line and sailed through the four and bit laps. Aleksandra Majewska-Ani crossed the line first in 9:08.34s for a PB. Stuart Bennett, recently returned from Madeira with a European Masters team silver medal, was next home a few seconds later to take the M65 title.

In the 10000m race Grazia Manzotti was a clear winner, just short of her own BMAF record in 57:24.81s. Carolyn Derbyshire was second home, closely followed by Trevor Jones who took the M65 title. The latter was the only contested age category of the day. Further down the field Susan Payne improved her PB by fifty seconds.
