National

England Athletics Indoor Race Walk Championships, E.I.S. Sheffield (Sun. 19th Jan.)

The England Athletics Indoor, now referred to as short track, took place on 19th January at the English Institute of Sport in Sheffield. With a large contingent of Irish athletes in attendance and an improved entry numbers from UK athletes, resulted in five races, which produced some excellent racing and a great advert for race walking.

The main titles over 3,000 meters were won by Cameron Corbishley, from Medway and Maidstone AC, with 11:38.51, and Hannah Hopper (U23), from Cambridge Harriers, with a personal best of 14:16.93.



In the men's race, second position was achieved by Irish under-20 Luke Fitzmaurice, with 14:28.65, with Trejan Checheku-Boamah, of Blackheath & Bromley, taking the under-17 title with 16:44.17.

In the women's race, it was Irish athletes who followed Hopper in the immediate places of the general classification, namely Robin Og Murphy, with 14:38.61, and the under-23 Ciara Wilson Bowen, with 14:42.46. The England championship podium, this was completed by Jessica Wilton, from Ashford AC, with 15:15.27, and Natasha Mitchell, from Southampton AC, with 15:35.05.



In other races, there were the victories of Leah O'Gara (Finn Valley AC/Ireland, 16:10.46) in the women's under-17 3,000 meters, Timothy William Perry (Northern (IOM) AC, 4:39.01) and Cuisle O'Callaghan (Ireland, 4:40.55) in the under-15 1000 meters, and finally Spencer Tate Jones (Wrexham AAC, 5:27.01) and Ava Dinkin (Ireland, 5:30.54), also in the 1,000 meters, in the under-13 development race.
