Men's 35km (50 started)

Bronze medallist in the 50 km at the Tokyo Olympic Games in 2021, Canadian Evan Dunfee returned to the Japanese capital to win the world title over 35 km with 2:28:22, ahead of silver Caio Bonfim (Brazil, 2:28:55) and bronze Hayato Katsuki (Japan, 2:29:16).

Women's 35km (46 started)

Two years after winning gold in the 20 and 35 km at the World Championships in Budapest, the Spaniard María Pérez was again crowned world champion for 35 km winning with 2:39:01. Silver went to Italian Antonella Palmisano (2:42:24) and bronze to Paula Torres of Ecuador in a National Record of 2:42:44.

The minor medals went to Mexican Alegna González, with a new Mexican and Area record of 1:26:06 and the Japanese Nanako Fujii, with 1:26:18 a national record. There was also a national record achieved by Kimberly Garcia Leon (PER) of 1:26:22

Overseas

Sprint Race Walking Triathlon, Drunen (NED) (Sat. 27th Sept.)

Twelve athletes lined up in the Sprint Race Walking Triathlon, held in Drunen, Netherlands, writes **Frank van Ravensberg**. Although the number of participants was lower than in previous years, the results of the male and female winners were the best in the last five editions.

For the first time, the victory in the men's race was won by an English athlete, Luc Legon, who triumphed in all three distances, always by a wide margin. Legon completed the 3000m in 12:51.8s, the 1000m in 3:56.5s and the mile in 6:39.4s. The winners of the 15 previous editions

of the Sprint Triathlon came from the following countries: Slovakia, Ireland, Belgium, the Netherlands, Germany, Poland and Spain.

The mile race provided a very lively fight between Edwin van Wijngaarden, Remco de Bruin and Anne van Andel for the places behind Legon. Van Andel would finish the distance in second place (women's winner), with 7:35.4s, improving by 0.2 seconds the best race record, obtained in 2012 by the Irish Kate Veale. In the immediate places finished Van Wijngaarden (7:35.7) and De Bruin (7:36.0).

In all three distances, Van Wijngaarden was in second place and De Bruin in third. Van Andel was the women's winner, fourth overall, mainly because she did not commit herself to the 1000 meters. In the 3000m, Van Andel broke the Dutch women's W35 record, taking more than a minute off it to set it at 14:19.4s. It was Van Andel's seventh victory in the Sprint Triathlon.

Liesbet De Smet (Belgium) finished the women's competition in second place and Geraldine Legon (England) was third.
