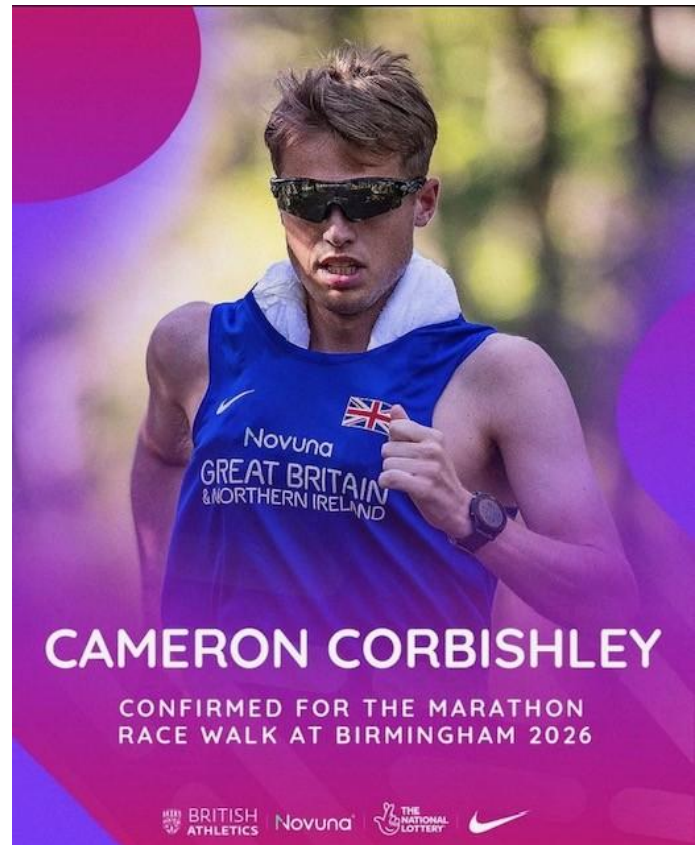

CORBISHLEY SELECTED FOR THE NOVUNA GB & NI TEAM FOR THE RACEWALK FOR BIRMINGHAM 2026



CAMERON CORBISHLEY

CONFIRMED FOR THE MARATHON RACE WALK AT BIRMINGHAM 2026



UK Athletics can announce the selection of Cameron Corbishley (club: Medway and Maidstone, coach: Andi Drake) to represent the Novuna Great Britain and Northern Ireland (GB & NI) team in the marathon race walk at the European Championships in Birmingham this summer.

His selection is subject to the final European Athletics Road to Birmingham ranking positions, which will be finalised on 30 July.

The athlete was selected in line with UK Athletics' selection policy aims, which are to secure a top 8 finish at the Championships and to support the team in placing top 3 in the medal table.

At the recent World Race Walking Team Championships in Brazil, Corbishley finished as 12th European across the line in the marathon. Last year, he performed above his world ranking at the World Championships in Tokyo and was recently crowned British Champion in the half-marathon distance in Leeds.

As of the start of the year, World Athletics has implemented changes to race walking, replacing 20km and 35km distances with marathon and half-marathon distances at major championships.

The European Championships marathon and half-marathon race walk will take place on the streets of Birmingham on the penultimate morning (Saturday 15 August) of the championships and will be free for the public to cheer on Corbishley and nations from across Europe.

Tom Craggs, World Class Programme Endurance Lead at UK Athletics, said: "Congratulations to Cameron and his team on being selected for the marathon race walk. Competing at a home championships will make this a particularly special occasion.

"He has an excellent pedigree, competing over a range of distances at European and World level, with a good showing in Brazil, finishing among the top 12 European athletes. We're looking forward to seeing him represent the Novuna GB & NI team in Birmingham this summer."

CORBISHLEY 32ND AT 2026 WORLD ATHLETICS RACE WALKING TEAM CHAMPIONSHIPS

Cameron Corbishley (Andi Drake, Medway and Maidstone) finished 32nd in the men's Marathon Race Walk in 3:21.38, a seasons best, at the World Athletics Race Walking Team Championships Brasília 26

Corbishley, who came into the Championships ranked 46th, faced tough weather conditions and a four-minute penalty at 24km.

However, he was still able to finish the race and cross the line, improving on his 45th placing at the last World Athletics Race Walking Team Championships in the process.

Japan's Hayato Katsuki won the men's Marathon Race Walk in 3:04:58 CR, while David Hurtado (ECU) and Kazuya Iwai (JPN) rounded out the podium positions.

Corbishley sets new British record at first Half Marathon Race Walk National Championships

The inaugural UK Athletics Half Marathon race walk event took place on where Cameron Corbishley (Medway and Maidstone, coached by Andi Drake) clocked a new British record of 1:30:53.

The event was staged at the British Grand Prix of Race Walking and held at the Brownlee Centre in Leeds, brought to life by England Athletics Competition Grant who made this landmark event possible.

Cameron Corbishley (Medway and Maidstone, coached by Andi Drake), just two weeks after finishing 32nd at the World Athletics Race Walking Team Championships over the marathon distance, claimed both the UK and England titles over the Half Marathon distance. He clocked a new British record of 1:30:53 with the event incorporating the inaugural UK Athletics and England Athletics Championships over the new international distance.



Cumali Arslan claimed second and kept pace with Corbishley in the early stages of the race, crossing the line with a personal best of 1:33:07.

Emily Ghose (Tonbridge AC, coached by Noel Carmody) also made history, taking the first ever UK and England Athletics Half Marathon titles in the women's race with 2:03:58.

In the 10km race, 2018 Commonwealth Games bronze medallist Bethan Davies (Cardiff Athletics) took victory in 49:37, ahead of Adam Cowin in 50:26 and Abigail Jennings (Aldershot Farnham & District, coached by Verity Snook), who recorded a personal best of 50:33.



In the age-group events, Timothy Perry (Northern AC, Isle of Man) won the England Athletics Under-18 title over 5km in 25:57. Honey-Mae Davies (Manx Harriers) claimed the Under-18 girls' title with a new personal best of 29:29, while Lilee Fletcher-Merryweather (Manx Harriers) secured the England Under-16 title over 3km in a swift 14:34.

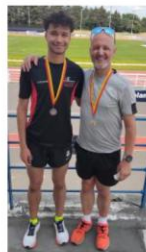
